



OKLAHOMA CLASSICS 2008 FOAL NOMINATION



A total of just \$375 makes your Oklahoma-Bred foals eligible for Oklahoma's Biggest Day of Racing for their entire racing career

Payment Schedule for 2008 Foals:

March 15, 2009 - \$75 to nominate Nov. 15, 2009 - \$150 to sustain Feb. 15, 2010 - \$150 Final Payment
If the nominator chooses to pay the total fees by March 15, 2009, he may do so for a total payment of \$325, thus receiving a \$50 reduction in costs.

Late Payment Schedule and Fees for 2008 Foals:

March 16, 2009 to June 15, 2009	\$125	(\$ 50 penalty + payment to date of \$75)
June 16, 2009 to Sept. 15, 2009	\$625	(\$400 penalty + nom fee and 11-15-09 payment)
Sept. 16, 2009 to Dec. 31, 2009	\$750	(\$525 penalty + nom fee and 11-15-09 payment)
Jan. 1, 2010 to April 1, 2010	\$2,700	\$2,325 penalty + all payments of \$375)
April 2, 2010 to July 31, 2010	\$10,000	(Last date to nominate 2008 foals)

If foal was nominated and the second payment was made, but the third payment was missed, the owner may pay a fee of \$900 up to 5-31-2010 to continue eligibility. After that date the above late payment schedule will take effect. Anyone with questions may contact the O.T.A. office.

All payments must be postmarked by the due date to be acceptable. Further payment notices may or may not be mailed to nominators prior to any payment due date. Responsibility for keeping nominated horses eligible is upon the person nominating. Any changes to a horse's status should be reported to the O.T.A. (such as change in ownership, name, etc.)

“Special Conditions for OKLAHOMA CLASSICS”

1. Nomination fees received by Oklahoma Thoroughbred Association for the “OKLAHOMA CLASSICS” (hereinafter “OC”) will be allocated to the “OKLAHOMA CLASSICS” races exclusively. Only those “Accredited Oklahoma-Breds” who nominate to the “Oklahoma Classics” will be eligible for “Oklahoma Classics” races.

2. The gross purse for “OC” races will be posted prior to the normal close of entries with entry and starting fees to be added to each race's purse respectively with 50% of race sponsorships added to purses and awards. Added monies are tentative and are subject to change. O.T.A. will retain all interest and 10% of nomination and sustaining payments for administrative expenses. The purses will be paid according to race conditions which are as follows: First 60%, Second 20%, Third 11%, Fourth 6%, and Fifth 3% with all Oklahoma-Bred Funds to be paid according to the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission schedule.

3. There will be no supplements allowed or late nominations except as outlined in the payment schedule or through designated supplements for one year's races with payment of supplement fee as outlined in approved forms.

4. The O.T.A. will not refund fees for any reason. It is responsibility of nominator to determine if foal is eligible for Oklahoma-Bred status.

5. The O.T.A. reserves the right to refuse or revoke the eligibility of any horse nominated in the event that the nominator and/or owner fails to pay the nomination fee, or additional eligibility payments, or late charges as set forth in the payment schedule, when due.

6. The O.T.A. reserves the right to postpone or change the conditions of all or any part of the “OC” without any liability. “OC” programs may be cancelled without notice and the O.T.A. shall have no liability except to make distribution of all nomination fees not paid in prior races less any interest accrued and 10% administrative fees. Monies from entry fees are not necessarily designated to any particular year's purse payments; therefore, in the event of cancellation of the “OC” any refunds to nominators and/or owners may be less than the original amount of nomination and sustaining payments made.

7. In the event that any horse becomes ineligible to run in any of the “OC” races for any reason whatsoever, no refunds of nomination fees will be allowed. Nominations and entries in any of the races are accepted on the condition that all claims and objections arising out of the race or with respect to any interpretation of any rules or conditions of the race, or otherwise, shall be decided by the O.T.A.,

the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission and/or the presiding stewards of the racing meet at which the races have or are being conducted.

8. The “OC” races will be run in compliance with the racing rules and regulations of the applicable authority having jurisdiction of the track where such races are held and must comply with all rules and regulations of the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. O.T.A. shall have no liability for the actions of any such track or for any matter under the control of such track, its officials or employees. Purse and award payments shall be made to the owners or lessees recognized as such by such track and authority. Nominations are made with the express understanding that said nomination does not assure stall space for horses nominated.

9. The O.T.A. reserves the right to televise, broadcast and/or record (on film or tape) certain horses, races, and the activities incidental to them, and to broadcast, exhibit and/or exploit same by means now or hereafter now. O.T.A. further reserves all rights to advertise the “OC” in any manner it deems appropriate, including the use of the names and likenesses of horses and/or their offspring. The nominator and/or owner hereby expressly and irrevocably waives any releases and rights he has in connection with any matter referred to in this paragraph, including, without limitation, any claim to invasion of the right to privacy or to misappropriation. Nominator and/or owner further grants his consent to be photographed in a motion picture, television program or otherwise in public places without remuneration to him. The nominator and/or owner understands and agrees that any use by him of the name, logo, or material relating to the “OC” programs will be restricted by the O.T.A.

10. O.T.A. reserves the right to limit the number of entries in any of the races sponsored by the O.T.A. In the event O.T.A. determines it must limit entries, entries will be selected according to the individual race conditions as put forth by the host track's racing secretary or by other methods as the O.T.A. may determine in its sole discretion. O.T.A. reserves the right to modify the distance of any race to accommodate the track selected for every race.

11. All claims and objections arising out of the application or interpretation of any rules or conditions of “OC” shall be decided solely by O.T.A.

12. All nomination and sustaining payments should be sent by registered or certified mail, **postmarked not later than date payment is due**. The sender's receipt must be presented as proof of payment should any discrepancy occur.
